

Checking the FCC Database for your New or Updated Call Sign

Easy, If you Created an FRN# before your First Test

1. <https://wireless2.fcc.gov/UlsEntry/licManager/login.jsp> (Hit Enter)
2. Enter FRN# and Password, Click Submit.
3. If you have no licenses, it will say no licenses associated.
4. If you have a new License now, you will see your new CallSign
- 5. Click “View Complete License Below” to see your details.**

Easy,with your FRN#, Already Have a CallSign

1. <http://wireless2.fcc.gov/UlsApp/UlsSearch/searchLicense.jsp> (Hit Enter)
2. Click on “**By CallSign**” (Left in the search window)
- 3. Type in your FRN# then click Search.**
- 4. Click your CallSign for details.**

Using Your Existing Callsign

Type into your browser window the following URL:

1. <http://wireless2.fcc.gov/UlsApp/UlsSearch/searchLicense.jsp> (Hit Enter)
2. Click on “**By CallSign**”
3. Type in the ***Callsign*** you are researching
4. Click on “**SEARCH**”
5. Click on “**Your CallSign**” to see if it has been updated.

The information in the FCC Database will be displayed. Use your BACK button (on browser) to return to “Callsign” in step #3 and hit the “clear” button. Retype the new Callsign you are researching and use the same procedure.

Waiting on your New Callsign

<http://wireless2.fcc.gov/UlsApp/UlsSearch/searchLicense.jsp> (Hit Enter)

1. Click on “**Advanced License Search**” (bottom of the search window)
2. Type in your **Name** (using this format.,, Public, John Q)
3. Type in the City then State in State Window.
4. The number of rows may need to be increased if first search doesn’t yield desired results.
5. Click on “**Search**”
6. If Found: Click on “**CallSign**” to see the details of the Call.

The information in the FCC Database will be displayed. Use your BACK button (on browser) to return to the Search Window. Hit your Browsers “Refresh Button” to search again, or Hit the “Refresh Button” on the Search Window to clear the form for another Search.
